About Nikolaos Skubas, MD

Dr. Skubas earned his medical degree from Aristoteles University in Thessaloniki, Greece. He completed his internship and anesthesiology residency at University Hospitals Case Medical Center and a two-year fellowship in Cardiothoracic Anesthesiology at Washington University in St. Louis, Barnes-Jewish Hospital. Dr. Skubas is a fellow of the American Society of Echocardiography (FASE) and American College of Cardiology (FACC).

Dr. Skubas served as an Assistant Professor of Anesthesiology at Washington University until 2000, when he returned to his native country to practice cardiac anesthesia with a private group. He was recruited by Weill Cornell Medicine in 2002 to lead the echocardiography activities of the Division of Cardiac Anesthesia. He became Director of Cardiac Anesthesia in 2009. During his tenure at Weill Cornell Medicine, he was instrumental in launching the heart surgery activities at New York Methodist Hospital in 2004. Dr. Skubas fostered the programmatic evolution of the Division of Cardiac Anesthesia via its collaboration with the transcatheter valve program, echocardiographic services for percutaneous interventions and, in 2016, the launching of robotic heart surgery. He has served on a number of departmental committees.

Dr. Skubas has published extensively in peer-reviewed journals, and co-authored practice guidelines sponsored by the American Society of Echocardiography, American College of Cardiology and American Heart Association. He has authored many book chapters and is a coeditor of the Problem-Oriented Patient Management, 8th edition. He has served on the editorial board of the journal Anesthesia and Analgesia (A & A) since 2005 and he is the Executive Section Editor for Perioperative Echocardiography and Cardiovascular Education for A & A. He also is an associate editor for the journal Anesthesiology.

Dr. Skubas is serving as a Co-Chair of the Society of Cardiovascular Anesthesiologists Annual Comprehensive Review & Update of Perioperative Echo Meeting, the largest perioperative echocardiography meeting of its kind. He also is a member of the Basic Perioperative Transesophageal Echocardiography (Basic PTeXAM) Writing Committee of the National Board of Echocardiography, which provides board certification in echocardiography. Dr. Skubas also is the Chair of the Fellow of the American Society of Echocardiography (FASE) Advisory Committee.
