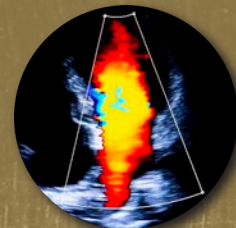

She recently served as the lead author on an innovative joint STS/SCA/AmSECT study providing clinical practice guidelines on anticoagulation for cardiac surgery procedures requiring cardiopulmonary bypass surgery.

What inspired you to pursue a career in this field?

Cardiac anesthesiology is a field that is rich in research and innovation.
