Position and Organization Benjamin G. Covino Professor of Anesthesia at Harvard Medical School Stanton has published over 250 original manuscripts, review articles, and textbook chapters on the etiology and management of perioperative systemic inflammation, as well as myocardial ischemia and reperfusion injury in cardiac surgical patients, and the role of perioperative echocardiography in clinical and surgical decisionmaking.

He has also been invited to lecture as a Visiting Professor or a speaker at numerous high-profile institutions and academic society annual meetings on a national and international level. Dr. Shernan is a Co-Editor of the textbooks entitled *Comprehensive Three-Dimensional Echocardiography Atlas; Clinical Transesophageal Echocardiography: A Problem Oriented Approach, the Comprehensive Textbook of Intraoperative Transesophageal Echocardiography*, as well as the web-based textbook at <u>www.e-echocardiography.com</u>.

He is a Senior Editor for Anesthesia and Analgesia, a Senior Consulting Editor of the Journal of the American Society of Echocardiography, and a Consultant Reviewer for many other journals in the areas of anesthesiology, cardiac surgery, cardiology, and echocardiography.
