In Memoriam NBE Immediate Past President Roberto M. Lang, MD

It is with deep sadness that the National Board of Echocardiography (NBE) announces the passing of our esteemed President, Dr. Roberto Lang, on June 10, 2025, at the age of 73. A beloved husband, father, abuelo, friend, mentor, and internationally recognized leader in cardiology, Dr. Lang leaves behind a legacy of excellence, innovation, and compassion.

Born in Buenos Aires, he completed his medical training in Argentina and Israel before immigrating to the U.S., where he completed his cardiology fellowship at the University of



Chicago and remained on faculty for 40 years. A pioneer in 3D echocardiography, he revolutionized cardiac imaging and care worldwide.

Dr. Lang passed the ASCeXAM® in 1996 and was among the first certified by NBE in 2001. He served on the ASCeXAM Writing Committee, joined the Board in 2014, and became President in 2023. He also led international outreach in South America, expanding access to echocardiographic education and certification, and served as President of the American Society of Echocardiography (2009–2010).

Beyond his professional achievements, Roberto will be remembered for his mentorship, humor, humility, and deep love for his family. He is survived by his wife of 47 years, Lili; children Gabriel (Lindsey) and Daniella; and grandchildren Jacob and Levi—his greatest joy.

His passing leaves a profound void in the echocardiography community and the lives of all who knew him. His legacy lives on in the hearts he touched, the minds he shaped, and the field he transformed. More about Dr. Lang here.

Certification Committee.


